

Know Your Fire Evacuation Zone

During a wildfire, you may see evacuation orders and warnings that reference alphanumeric zones. If you are in Los Angeles County you can find your evacuation zone by visiting **protect.genasys.com** and entering your address. The map will zoom into your location and show your zone designation. Write it down, then zoom out a bit and take a screenshot of your surrounding area so you know the adjacent zones to determine when orders and warnings are getting closer to your area.

Los Angeles City zones will begin with LFD, followed by several digits. Other incorporated cities will have their own three-letter prefix (BRK for Burbank, GLN for Glendale, etc.), and unincorporated Los Angeles County zones will have a descriptive or abbreviated location name, sometimes preceded by LAC. Below is a zoomed-out map screenshot. You'll get more detail as you zoom in.
